AQMD Approves Clean-Technology Grants for San Bernardino and Boyle Heights

AQMD is the air pollution control agency for major portions of San Bernardino, Los Angeles and Riverside counties and all of Orange County.

To help implement its Clean Communities Plan, adopted in November 2010 to reduce cumulative impacts of air pollution and air toxics throughout the Southland, the South Coast AQMD today approved a grant program to help reduce air pollution and toxic air contaminants in the City of San Bernardino and Boyle Heights. Grants are available to schools, day care centers and government entities that switch to more environmentally friendly janitorial cleaners.

Green Cleaner Program:

Up to \$100 per unit is available for the purchase and installation of green cleaning product dispensing systems. Schools, daycare centers, and government entities are eligible and incentives are available from manufacturers selling AQMD-approved cleaning products.
